Schedule / Compensation:

General cleaning will be a weekly roll. This position may be scheduled up to 40 hours a week and pay will be discussed based on experience.
- **Experienced Electrician/Plumber:** Seeking self-motivation knowledgeable individual experienced with or the will to learn 3 phase electric and general plumbing with the ability to complete projects in a timely manner. Also willing to help other departments in the maintenance group when projects are caught up.
- **Facilities and Groundskeeping:** Looking for motivated, self-driven workers to perform tasks such as weed-eating, fence repair, lifting and moving materials—bike rack and various materials around the track.
