## COMPETITION CLASSES

### Top Gun Class

- 1/4 Mile - Heads Up - .400 Pro Tree
- Clocks Off – Timeslip can be acquire from the WWTslip app
- Slicks or drag / performance radials ONLY - No treaded street tires
- NO tube chassis
- Two Qualifying sessions
- Top 8 cars will advance to eliminations

### Stick Shift Class

- 1/4 Mile - Heads Up - .400 Pro Tree
- Clocks Off - Timeslip can be acquire from the WWTslip app
- H-pattern manual transmission ONLY
- ANY tire allowed
- Two Time Trials
- Top 16 Cars will advance to eliminations.
- Towing is PROHIBITED

### Street Class

- 1/4 Mile - Heads Up - .400 Pro Tree
- Clocks Off - Timeslip can be acquire from the WWTslip app
- ANY Tire Allowed
- NO E.T. Electronics allowed in Any Class
- CLASS SPLIT BY E.T. BREAKS:
  - Cars will be put into groups of 8 based on performance in 2 Time Trial Passes
  - Quickest 8 qualifiers will be placed into the “A” Field
  - Next quickest 8 will enter the “B” Field
  - Next 8 into “C” Field
  - Any remaining cars will be placed in the “D” Field
  - To prevent sandbagging, each field will have an Index cap two tenths of a second quicker than the fastest car in Field (i.e. if the first car in “B” Field qualified at 10.23, Breakout will be 10.03, anyone running quicker than 10.03 will be DQ)
- Towing is PROHIBITED



**Time Slip Procedure:**

No times will be displayed on the scoreboard and for privacy purposes, racers must obtain a QR code. After the vehicle has passed tech, the Racers will need to see a WWT Raceway Official to obtain a QR Code. This code will give the racer access to his/her timeslips for up to 48 hours. Only the driver can scan the QR code to preserve the integrity of the No Time process.

**OIL DOWN RULE:**

If you leave oil or any other liquid on the track that requires a cleanup excess of 5 minutes, you will be done for the duration of the event. Repeat offenders (even if less than a 5-minute cleanup) may be asked to park their car for the duration of the event solely at the discretion of WWT Raceway Management. All decisions are final.
