



## 2026 VP Racing Lubricants Gateway Heads-Up Mafia, Bikes, & TNT Rules

This is designed to be a well-prepped race car-focused night at World Wide Technology Raceway. No Street tires will be permitted to preserve the track prep, tire rules do not apply to bikes. Must be on slick or drag radial, including TnT. Timeslips will be available via the app, clocks/scoreboards on. There will be 2 qualifier/shake down passes per class. In the event of unforeseen situations, qualifiers/shake downs may be adjusted at the track's discretion.

**Tech Card & Entry Fees: (Tech Card At Gate or via PitPay, Buy Ins for money pot are cash only. They are listed in each class rule. Bring exact change for Cash Buy Ins)**

## Class Rules/Buy Ins/Payouts:

### Gateway Heads-Up Mafia ALL CLASS Rules: (Bike/Jrs rules do not apply, and have specific rules below)

- .400 Pro Tree
- Chip Draw for 1st Round at Drivers Meeting after Qualifying. (in pits with Racer Relations team)
  - 1st Round Callouts if desired. (in pits with the racer relations team). You or a representative must be present for chip draw or a chip will be drawn for you.
  - Subsequent rounds/elims will be **chip draw each round in staging lanes**. (with the WWTR Staging team). It's your responsibility to be in the lanes for lane calls or you will forfeit your round.
- Clocks are ON.
- No Wheelie Bars in G28s, STL, Outlaw Street, Street Warrior, and Real Street
- Must be on Slick or Drag Radial during Gateway Heads-Up Mafia event. (including TnT.... Does not apply to bikes)
- CASH PAY OUT PER RACE. Sponsor Money+Car Count Buy Ins= Total Payouts. Some sponsor monies may be paid in a separate check. Payouts will be announced at driver's meeting.
- CASH BUY IN (paid in pits with racer relations team after you tech your car.)
  - **BRING YOUR TECH CARD AND CASH BUY IN TO RACER RELATION TEAM TO REGISTER FOR THE MONEY POT. (Except Bikes and Jrs)**
- Racers in violation of the rules will lose your tech card for that race.
- Tech Card carries over to TnT. If eliminated you can still run with TnT.
- Will use the PA system, What's App, and 106.7 for Lane Calls.
- Courtesy staging will be encouraged by Track Officials.
- Sportsmanship will be enforced.
- Race Questions directed at Racer Relations Team. **(Join the Gateway Heads-Up Mafia Facebook Group for updates and information about the team/program.)**
- Stack for eliminations per WWTR Staff directive. They will pair you with your opponent. Stacking instructions will be provided at the Drivers Meeting by WWTR Staff.
- Diapers are highly encouraged. See oil down policy.
- Run Order: TNT, 7.90 Jr Dragster, S/MX, prep, G28, STL, Outlaw Street, Street Warriors, Real Street, sc bike, 6.0&7.0 Index
- Breakout rules do not apply to bye runs.
- All cars must break beams in eliminations under their own power.
- All Bye Runs must break beams. (can be pushed back).
- All rules are Racer Regulated. (All Contested Call Outs, must be done before Semi-Finals)
  - To Contest a rule: Call Out Fees are listed below and need to be paid to Racer Relations team **in cash** to contest a rule violation. If you are correct and choose to enforce, your



call out fee will be returned. If incorrect or choose to not enforce, Call out fee goes into that class pot.

- G28/STL/6.0 and 7.0 Index= \$100
- Outlaw Street/Street Warriort/Real Street=\$50
- Address Racer Relations teams with racer/car number/rule and put up the Call Out Fee.
- The Racer Relation team will investigate and decide the best course of action. (removal from class for that race, or if the racers of that class decide to let them run)
- All Racers are responsible to pick up their winnings/trophies the DAY OF RACE. Report to the racer relation team at the end of night, and/or Race Control (room 208) as applicable. (Payouts/Trophies advised at Driver's Meeting).
- You are ALLOWED to run multiple payout classes, but you must purchase a tech card for each class and buy in separately to each class.
- 6 car Minimum for sponsor contributions

## **2026 Gateway Heads-Up Mafia Specific Payout Class Rules**

**Gangsta 28's:** Buy In: \$300 at racer relations in pits.

- 1/8<sup>th</sup> Mile Heads Up Racing, No Cap
- Max Tire Size: 28x10.5 or 275 Radial tire permitted (no W's)
- Push Cars Allowed
- 1<sup>st</sup> Round Buy-Backs are allowed: Buy back equal \$ to buy in at racer relations.
- Payouts: 100% to Winner

**Small Tire Limited:** Buy In: \$100 at racer relations in pits.

- 1/8<sup>th</sup> Mile Heads Up Racing: Random Cap
  - Random Cap Draw during Tech: **4.90/5.10/5.30** Announced just before 1<sup>st</sup> qualifying.
  - If both cars break out, closest to breakout wins. Breakout rule applies in finals.
  - Disappearing Chip for Cap. Each race one chip will disappear after being drawn for the cap. And reset after 2 chips are in bag. There will never be less than 2 chips in the draw bag.
- Steel Roof and Quarters unless OEM.
- Max Tire Size: 28x10.5 or 275 Radial tire permitted (no W's)
- Push Cars Allowed
- Payouts: 80/20 Split



**“Street Car” Classes (Outlaw Street, Street Warrior, Real Street):**

Buy In: \$60 at racer relations in pits

- 1/4 Mile Heads Up Racing. Cap/Grouped into 3 groups
  - Each Group Outlaw Street, Street Warrior, and Real Street paid out.
    - Outlaw Street= 8.60 ET Cap
    - Street Warrior= 9.50 ET Cap
    - Real Street= 10.75 ET Cap
  - If Both cars break out, the closest to breakout wins. Breakout rule applies in finals.
- Max Tire Size: 28x10.5 or 275 Radial tire permitted (no W's), 17" + Rim size has no tire size limit.
- No towing/push cars to and from the lanes, cars must be driven everywhere (once on property).
  - Towing allowed after a break on the pass on the return road.
  - Will result in disqualification if using push/tow cars thru lanes/return road.
- Payouts: 80/20 Split per sub group of class.

**6.0/7.0 Index : (NEW for 2026, slated for first three races 4/4,5/2,6/20)**

Buy In: \$100 at racer relations in pits

- 1/8 Mile Pro Tree Heads Up Racing
  - 6.0 Index Group
  - 7.0 Index Group
  - If Both cars break out, the closest to breakout wins. Breakout rule applies in finals.
- No Tire Size limitation- Must be on slick or drag radial.
- No air or electronic throttle stops.
- Push Cars Allowed
- Payouts: 80/20 Split per sub group of class.

**Thoroughbred Realty Group 7.90 JR Dragsters: (Dates 4/4, 5/2, 5/30, 6/20, 7/18, 8/29, 10/23-24)**

\$60 Tech Card Only includes Racer and one crew- No Supplemental Buy In

- 1/8 Mile Heads Up Racing
- .500 Pro Tree
- 7.90 Max ET
- Jrs are only Tow/push, no driving on return road/staging lanes.
- Tech Cards will be turned into WWTR Track Staff at staging lanes.
- Chip Draw every round in staging lanes.
- All purses are from Sponsors and paid at Race Control after Finals
- All NHRA rules apply for safety.



**Phil's Plumbing Service & Repair Street Bike ET: (Dates 4/4, 5/2, 5/30, 6/20, 7/18, 8/29, 10/23-24)**

- Slider clutches prohibited
- Two-step rev limiters prohibited
- Wheelie bars are prohibited
- Delay boxes are not permitted
- D.O.T tires only, slicks are not permitted
- OEM hand clutch or hand activated clutch that stalls when released are permitted.
- Gen 2 multistage one stage are all permitted
- Aftermarket or flashed ECU are permitted
- Dataloggers are permitted
- Any power adder is permitted
- Air shifters are permitted
- Tuning capabilities are permitted
- The bike must have some type of taillight and a chain guard for safety.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Rd ONLY buybacks \$25
- Payout: Winner \$400, R/U \$200, Semi \$75
- 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> round will be chip draw at staging lanes (2<sup>nd</sup> round buybacks run buybacks), field laddered at Round 3.

**Super Comp Motorcycle: (Dates 4/4, 5/2, 5/30, 6/20, 7/18, 8/29, 10/23-24)**

Payout: Winner \$450, R/U \$200

- **Super Comp** is a 1/4 Mile, 8.90/9.20 Index class for drag and street bikes.
- This class is an all-run field. Pairings for all racers will be done by the World Wide Technology Raceway computer system and placed on a Pro ladder based on closest to index in qualifying.
- When either class gets down to one bike, one bye will be awarded, then you will merge into the majority class. (At this point, we will all be competing for the payout/trophy)
- The merge will occur after the 1 round bye is awarded. If there is an even number of bikes, then the competitor running closest to their index will receive a bye on the majority side. The merging bike will compete against the opponent that the bye bike was scheduled to run. In the case that there is a bye on the majority side, the merging competitor will compete against the bike who is scheduled to receive the bye. (Lane choice will be awarded to the competitor closest to their index during the merge)
- Index (Dial-In) is the competitor's responsibility. When the merge occurs, ensure that you have the right index on your board.
- A rider may only run one bike in this class. The same bike cannot be entered twice in this class by the same rider or another rider. However, a rider may enter both Street Bike and Super Comp Bike with the same bike.



- Changing Bikes: A racer can change his or her bike in time runs, qualifying, or before 1st round (You must notify the tower of changes). The bike and rider that runs first round is the one that must be used for eliminations, even if the class is completed on another weekend due to weather.

#### **TNT during VP Racing Gateway Heads-Up Mafia:**

- TNT is only to be entered by non-participants of any money pots. Unless you have been eliminated in one of those classes.
- 1/4 Mile TNT. (If wanting 1/8 mile, just read your slip)
- All cars must be on Slick or Drag Radial. No exceptions.
- .400 Pro Tree
- Grudge matches can also occur in this class. **If a racer wants No Time. It's their responsibility to label their cars N/T and ensure the Boards show "-----" prior to staging.**
- NHRA License passes allowed. Must have a car marked with "LIC".
- TNT will be called as a class, and run between classes. TNT will close during semi-finals, and finals.
- Anyone with a tech card for the event can jump into TNT after they have been eliminated from competition. Go for your personal best on the WWT Raceway ¼ Mile!
  - Example 1: Show up at Event and TNT only during the class calls for TNT.
  - Example 2: Enter into Payout Class during the event. If you are eliminated in any round, you can then enter into the TNT called class.
  - Special Note: Racers of Payout Classes should not enter ANY of the TnT class calls until eliminated.

**Oil Down Policy:** To expedite the program, any car that leaves oil/fluids requiring equipment to be used, or causes longer than a 5-minute cleanup may be asked to leave. Repeat offenders that constantly leak and slow down the program can also be asked to leave. This is solely at the discretion of WWT Raceway staff, and all decisions are final. Diapers are highly encouraged. We are trying to do everything possible to prevent timely delays for everyone participating.

#### **Points Series:**

Gangsta 28's, Small Tire Limited, Outlaw Street, Street Warriors, Real Street, and Phil's Plumbing Service & Repair Street Bike ET will collect championship points in 2026. No sign-up is required. Champion will receive a trophy and jacket at the 2026 season banquet. Points will be dropped for one lowest race. A rain out would count as a race with everyone receiving 0 points.

Gangsta 28's, Small Tire Limited, Outlaw Street, Street Warriors, Real Street, Phil's Plumbing Street Bike, Super Comp Bike, and 7.90 Jr Dragsters – Best 6 of 7 Events



For 2026, these are the only classes running points.

**Digital Time Slips:**

All time slips at WWT Raceway are Digital! Please download the *WWT Slips App* (designed by DynoGeeks), from the App Store or Google Play prior to your visit to WWT Raceway. The App is free on the App Store or Google Play. To get a time slip, you **MUST** download the app! Paper time slips will not be distributed.
